Australian Apprentice Wage Subsidy for Rural and Regional Locations

Updated Australian Apprentice Incentives Program Guidelines have been released today and there is good news for Group Training Organisations (GTOs).

These guidelines take effect from **1 January 2019**.

GTOs may be able to access the trial Australian Apprentice Wage Subsidy on behalf of small business host employers upon sign up of eligible Apprentices undertaking eligible qualifications on the National Skills Needs List in rural and regional workplace locations.

Our understanding is that a proportion of the available 1630 apprenticeships in each State and the Northern Territory has been allocated to GTOs to support small host employers.

This is a great result from NAEN's advocacy work over the last months to represent GTOs' significant role as a leading employer of Apprentices in rural and regional Australia.
