

# Release Notes

The following features and bug fixes were released on 9 February 2023.

## Apprenticeships

- Invalid records are now hidden by default on the Service Period, RTO History, Training Contract, and Management History tabs. Invalid records occur when an apprenticeship is created in ADMS, but the associated Training Contract is subsequently Rejected or Withdrawn.
- Network Providers can now see the status history for Apprenticeships that they manage.

## Training Contract

- Employer and Apprentice declarations on the Training Contract have been updated for clean energy commencements. These updated declarations will be displayed in the Additional Information area of the Training Contract PDF.
- Entries in the status column in the Training Contract list have now been colour coded:
  - entries in blue reflect that registration is pending,
  - entries in red show that registration has failed, and
  - entries in grey show that registration has been successful.

## Claim Applications

- Hiring Incentive claim application notification emails will now use the applicant's first name and surname, instead of listing the apprentice surname twice.
- Employers can now withdraw Hiring Incentive claim applications.
- Australian Apprentices will now be asked if they have provided a Tax File Number declaration form to their Network Provider when they complete Australian Apprentice Training Support Payment claim applications.

## TYIMS

- ADMS will no longer automatically update Registrations in TYIMS where the associated Apprenticeship ID is changed on the Training Contract. This is to prevent existing service periods from being overwritten in some circumstances.
- TYIMS will no longer display any ADMS BAC and CAC claim applications in the Claim Forms Error List.
